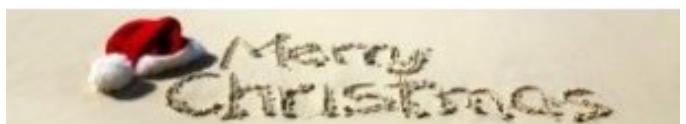
Week 10 Respect school property

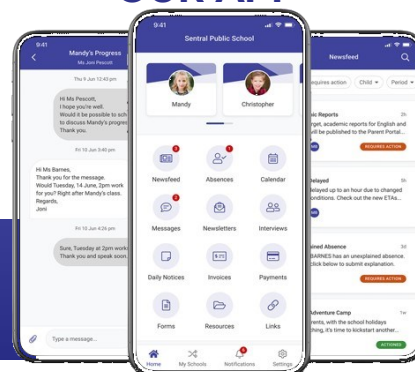

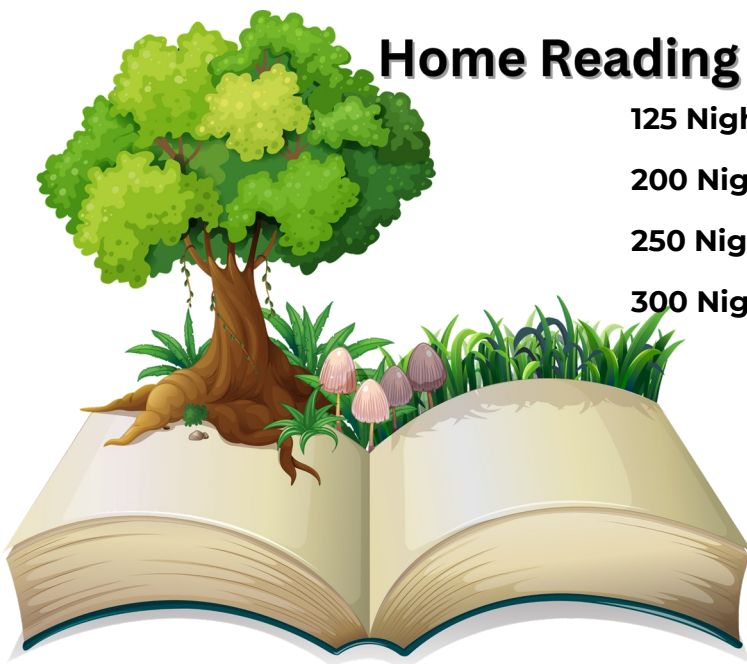
