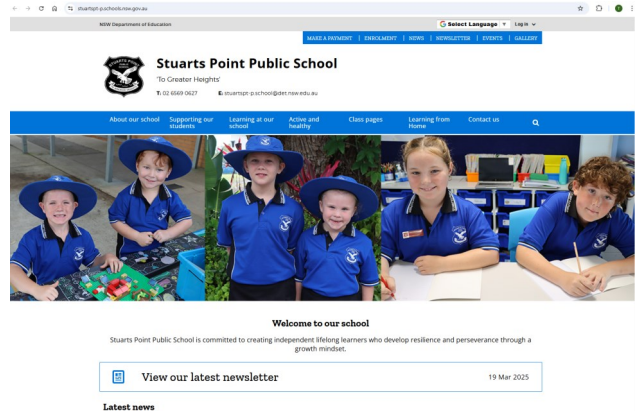
EGG DROP

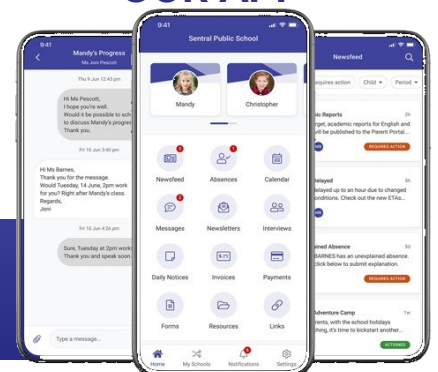

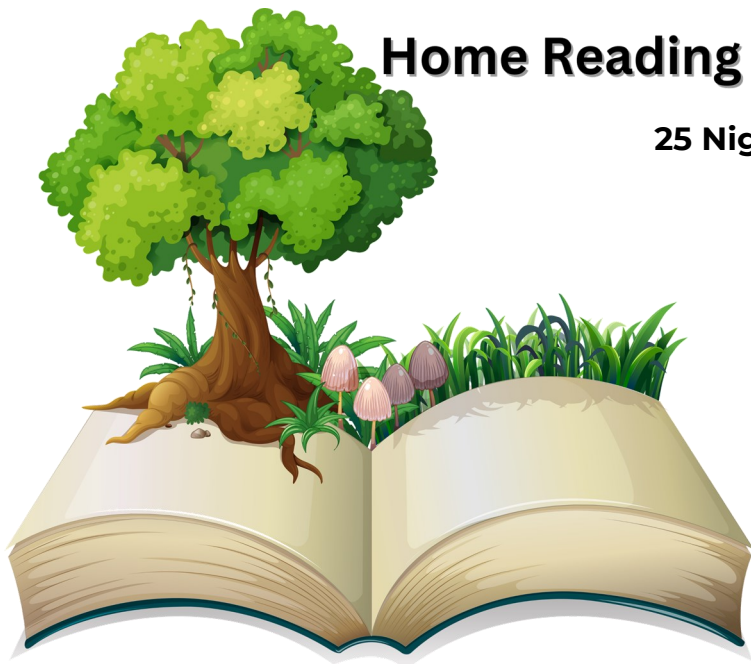
