Physical activity is valued for its physical, social and emotional benefits. It also helps young people to develop communication skills, confidence and resilience.

As part of our ongoing commitment to nurturing every student's potential, our school is trialling a series of focus groups aimed at implementing the NSW Department of Education's *High Potential and Gifted Education (HPGE)* policy more effectively. Focus groups will run fortnightly on odd weeks in the afternoon session from 1:45pm-3:00pm. This initiative represents a proactive step toward ensuring our learning environments recognise, value, and respond to the diverse talents and capabilities of our students.


#### Egg Drop
